

Seminole County Noise Ordinance

Noise from radios, cassette players, etc.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to play, use, operate or permit to be played, used, or operated any radio, tape recorder, cassette player or other machine or device for reproducing sound, if the sound generated is audible at a distance of 100 feet from the device producing the sound and if it is located in or on any of the following:

(1) Any public or private property, including any private or public street, highway, building, sidewalk, park or thoroughfare within Seminole County; or

(2) Any motor vehicle on private space or a public space, street or highway.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle on public or private space within the county in or on which the motor vehicle there is then being played, used, or operated, any radio, tape recorder, cassette player, or other machine or device for reproducing sound if the sound generated is audible at a distance of 100 feet from the device producing the sound.

(c) Any authorized public safety officer shall issue a summons for any violation of this section, except that they may arrest for instances when:

(1) The alleged violator refuses to provide the officer with such person's name and address and sufficient proof thereof as may be reasonably available to the alleged violator;

(2) When the alleged violator refuses to cease such illegal activity after being issued a citation.
